Introduction - User Manual

Overview

This document is the user manual for the admin users of the department, the agromet scientists and the farmers to help them use the CMS portal and the mobile app. It provides instructions on how to use **Agri CMS Portal and Megh Mitr Mobile App** to the system administrators and farmers. This manual offers specific instructions for system configuration and customization.

Scope of CMS Portal and Mobile App

Different government agencies or departments usually collect agricultural information and other valuable resources needed by the farmers, and it is essential to ensure that the efforts of each stakeholder complement the effort of others. Considering the information needs related to damage and losses assessments, one-stop access was requisite, which caters to the above-mentioned need of various government agencies, the system was developed for meeting this requirement.

Intended Audience

This document is intended to help the Agromet scientists with access to the CMS Portal and also to help the farmers understand the working of the Mobile App. This document is focused on functionalities and configurations of CMS Portal and Mobile App, for both Agromet Scientists as well as Farmers. Users may need an understanding of the Advisory addition to the Portal and how the data collected from the feedback will be processed.

How Tos

CMS Web Portal

The user can open the CMS web portal by visiting the website <http://139.59.3.76:8080/login>. We recommend using Google chrome or Firefox browsers to use the CMS.

The Admin user can create Advisory, view Advisory, add Feedback form for the Advisory, retrieve reports based on the response, modify feedback forms, advisory as per requirement

Step Wise Guide

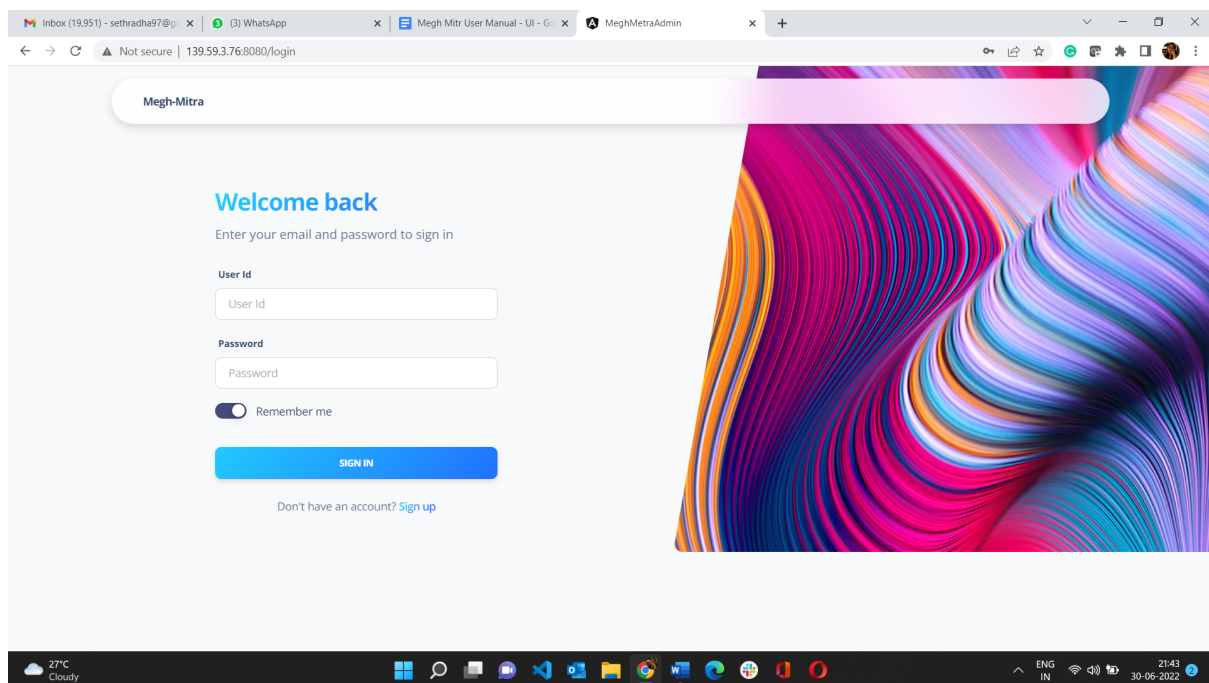
CMS Portal

User Login

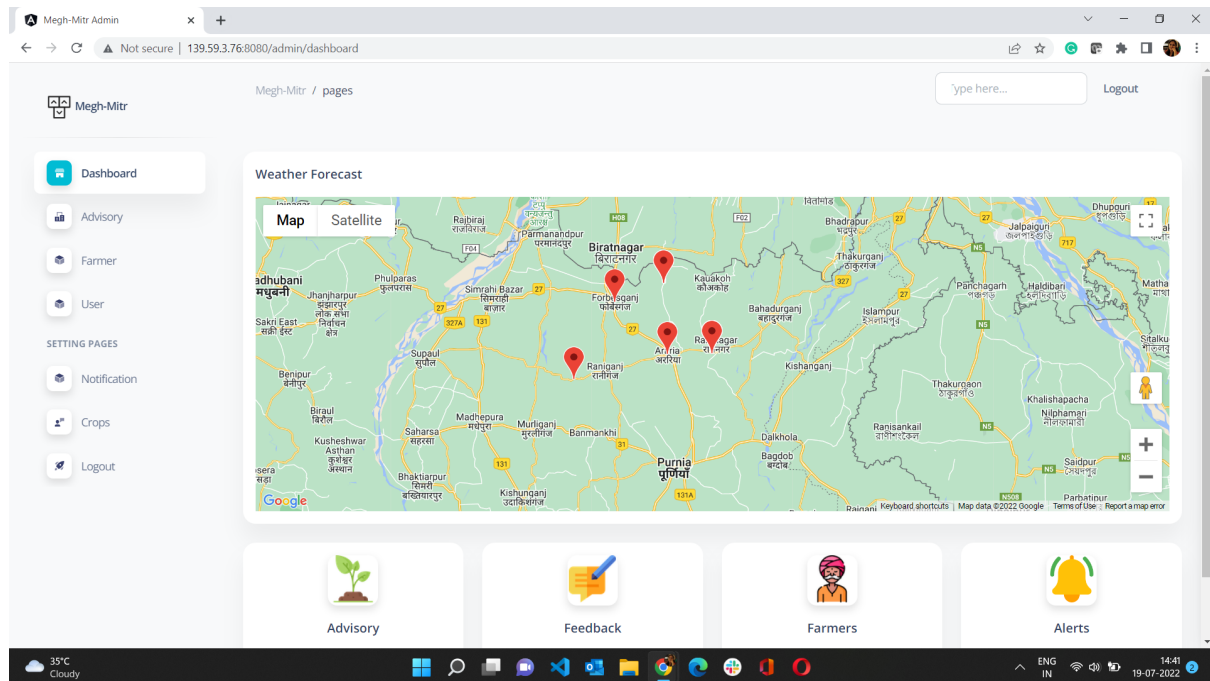
First, go to any Internet-enabled computer or laptop's Internet browser (such as Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, or Mozilla Firefox, etc.).

After this, the **login page** of the CMS portal will open as shown below:

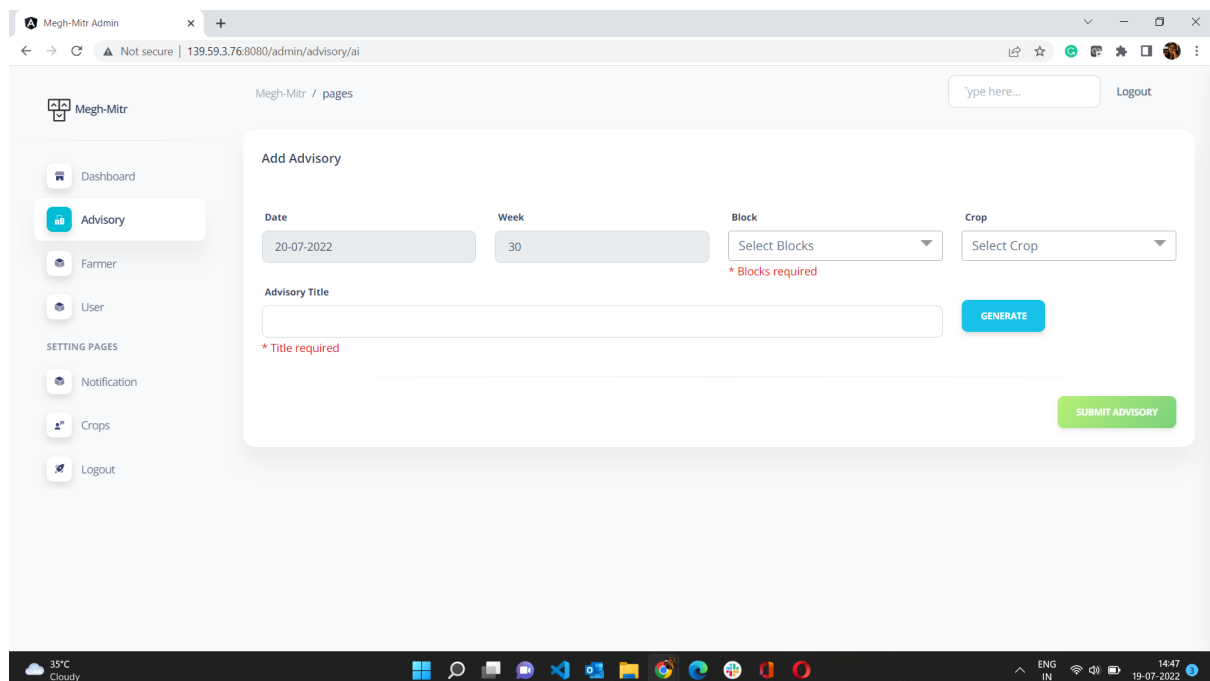


Enter User ID and Password and Click on the Sign In button

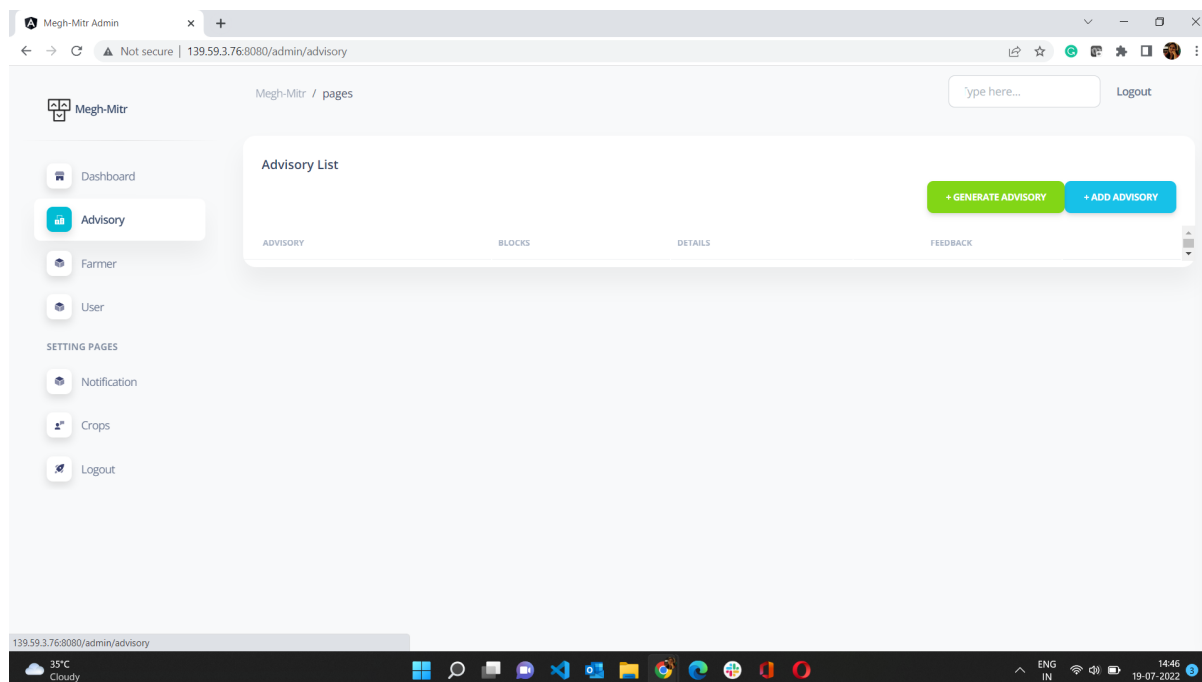


Logout

Generate Advisory adds a new Advisory based on crops automatically through AI

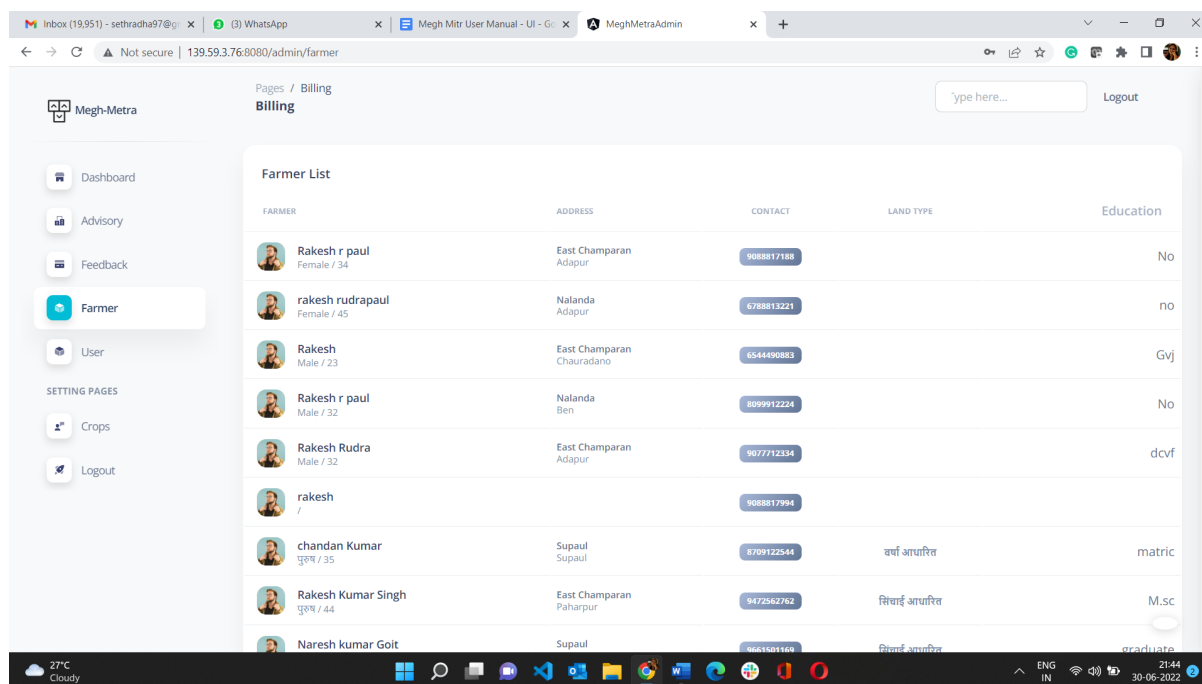


Advisory List

- Other details

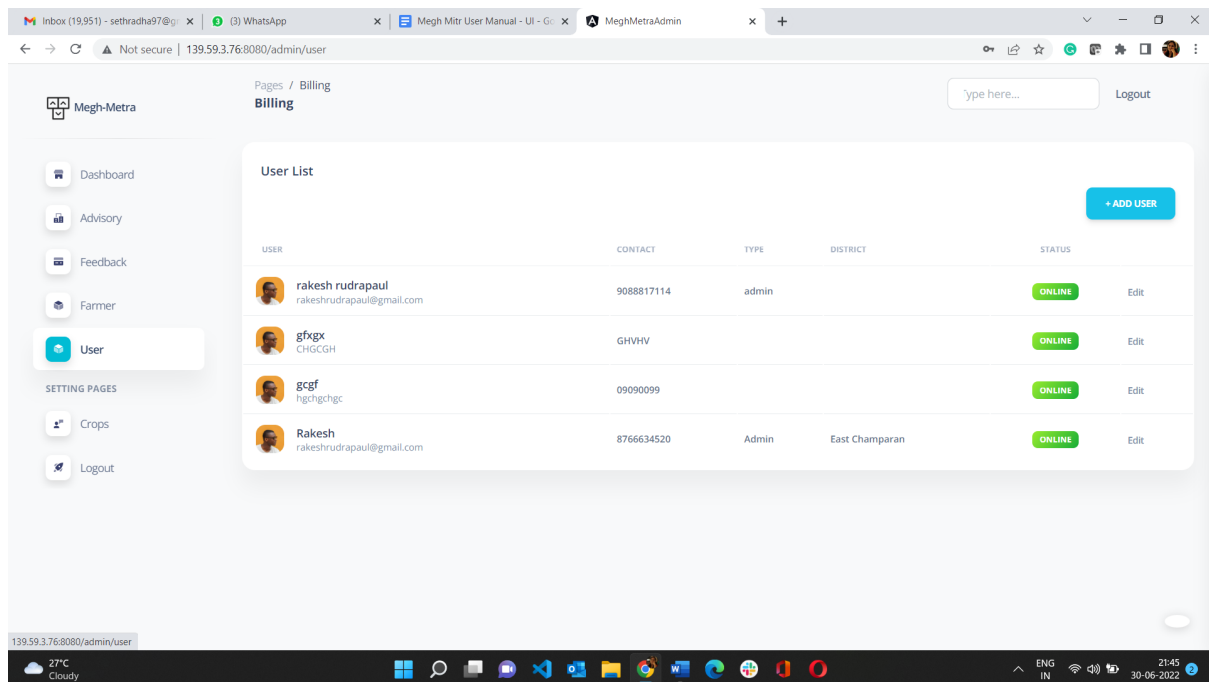
Add Advisory button allows adding new advisory manually

- Education

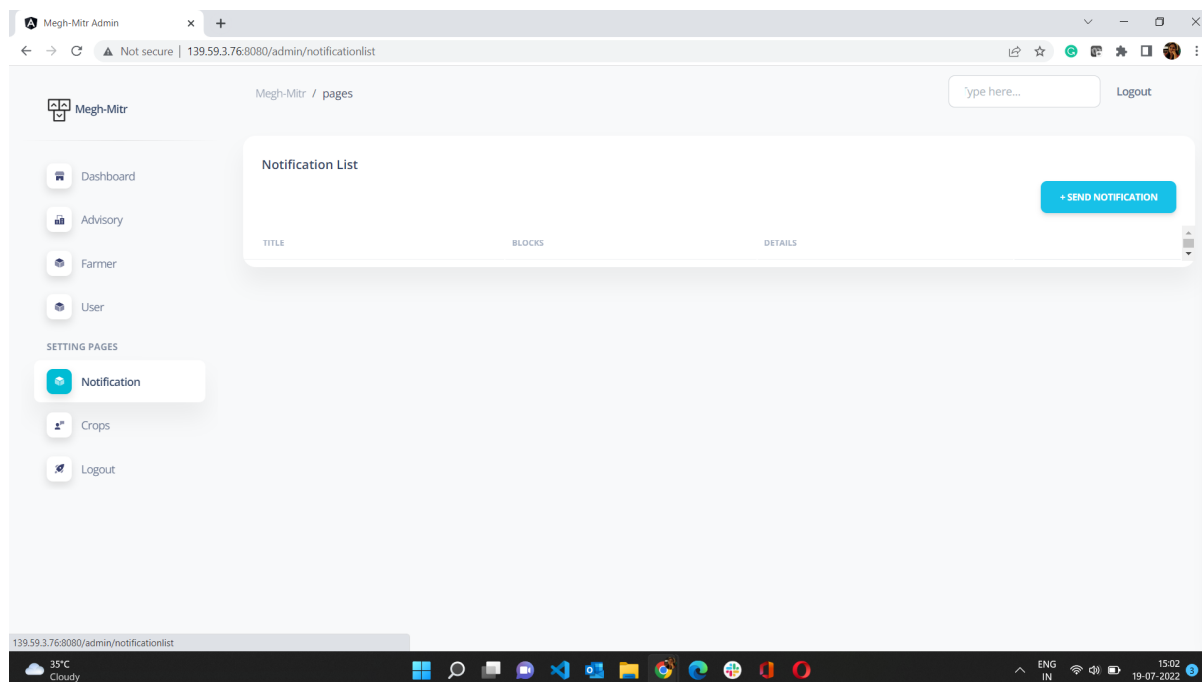


User List

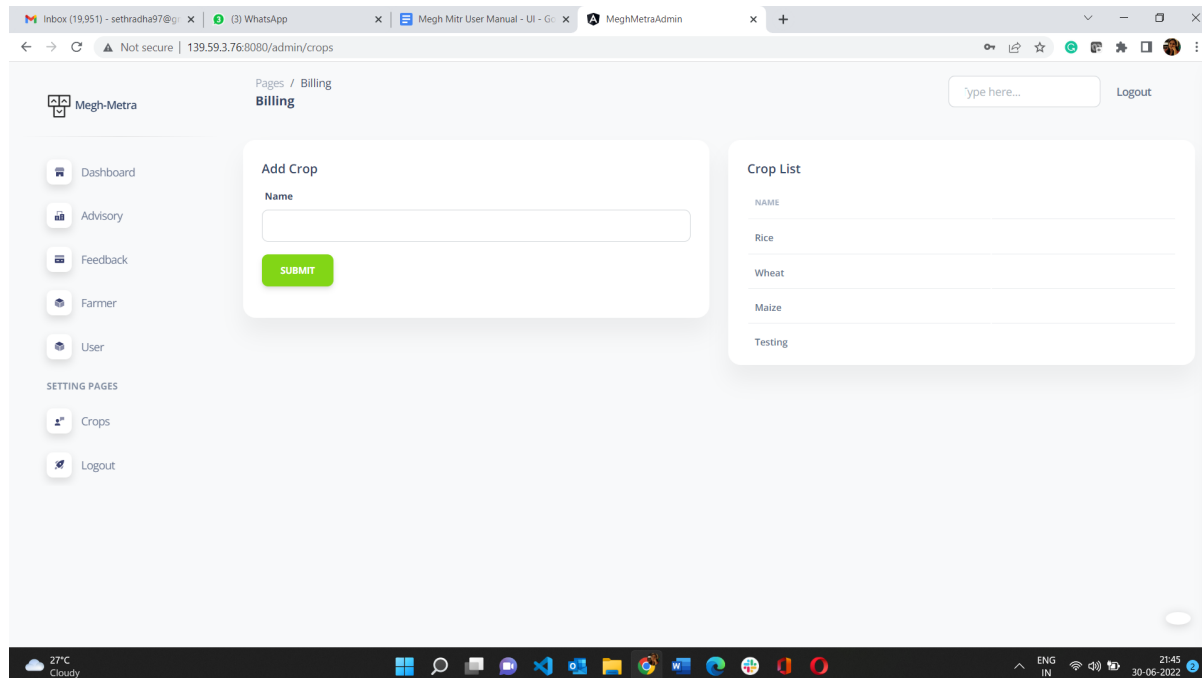
User List includes:
